At first I thought that this was a pretty big challenge that we are rising to meet. But then it got me thinking, what could we attain by the power of God right here in Ashland.

Remember in January when I preached about inviting your friends to church? What if we all started bringing our unchurched friends to church and in the next year saw 300 people in worship? What if we set a goal of 24 professions of faith in the next 12 months? That is only 2 a month. And I am not talking about membership transfers. I am talking about people being added to the family of God on a regular basis.

Or, what if we think about the people that we all know that are hurting and in pain due to the circumstances of life? We have ministry groups for all sorts of people. Surely you know someone who is a widow or widower that would benefit from Seniors without Partners. Or you know someone who is dealing with the hurts, habits, and hang-ups in life that would benefit from Restoration Recovery. Or you know a parent who has lost a child that would benefit from Loving Arms. Or you know someone who is dealing with just about anything that would benefit from a Stephen Minister. And while this is hard to quantify, we could set a goal of lives receiving healing and hope within the ministries of our church.

So, if paying off the mortgage and fixing the bell is not challenging enough, then let's pick one (or all) of those and get to work for the Kingdom.
