Last Sunday, we had our first bilingual worship service here at Corner-Stone and it was a beautiful day to be in the House of the Lord. I was moved by the show of support from members of this church as people came to worship God and welcome our new family into worship. This was the culmination of a year and a half of discerning the voice of God and preparing to begin this new ministry in the life of our church. While it was the conclusion of this process, it was just the beginning of what God is doing in our church right now.

The service went very well. But as is the case with anything new, there are changes that can be made. We are listening to the feedback we received from people who attended the service and making changes in order to make the service better. In this process, I am asking for your prayers. Pray for discernment for the worship team so we can make the changes that need to be made. Pray for people from within the Hispanic community who would be willing to help lead the service, especially in the area of music. And pray that God will draw people in to worship who currently do not have a church home. Also pray that our hearts will be ready to build relationships with new people as a part of the disciple making process.

Jesus instructed his disciples to go and make disciples. That is the mark of discipleship, that we are making other disciples. I was having a conversation with a friend of mine who works for a mission organization, and I asked him what is the main focus of his mission. He said they are focused on making disciples who make disciples who make disciples. If we as a church desire to see the Gospel of Jesus change the world, then we have to make disciples. You may be thinking this would be difficult for you with our new church family because of a language barrier. If that is the case, then find someone that you know - a neighbor, a coworker, a friend - and invest in their life so that they can grow as a disciple of Jesus. Together as a community, let's go make disciples.

Facing Our Fears A Fearless Thought from Pastor John

I have a huge fear of Ferris wheels. Yeah, I know, that seems like a ridiculous fear. But isn't that what fear really is ridiculous? Especially for a Christian.

Read 2 Timothy 1:7, Psalm 23:4, and 1 John 4:18.

My fear of Ferris wheels is irrational. I have never had a bad experience with them. I've never been dropped or stopped in a bad way. I do not know what it is that causes such white-knuckled fear. But there is one thing I do know: if one of my children asks me to ride a Ferris wheel, I will do it. I may hang on for dear life, but I will hop on and go along for the ride. Reluctantly and fearfully, but I will do it. Why? Well, for my kids. I want them to know that facing our fears is something we all must do. If we do not face our fears, we will not be able to live life. I want to teach my children to not let a fear keep them from living, even if it may be uncomfortable in the moment. We have such good family memories, especially those of riding Ferris wheels. In the moment, it is not so fun for me. But for my family, it is a real joy watching me ride. We look back over the experiences of life and we laugh at the good times we had as Dad faces his fears.

Maybe one day when Michael, Madison, and Nicholas are stopped in the tracks in fear, they will remember my example and push forward. Live life and make memories. We all know that we are called to live life abundantly in Jesus Christ. Living in fear is not how God has designed us. We are called to be bold and courageous. We are called to share the Good News of Jesus Christ. We are called to make disciples of Jesus Christ. We cannot live that abundant life if we are stopped in our tracks by fear. Ferris wheels have gotten easier to ride over the years simply because I face my fears. Don't tell the kids (or Stacia), but I do ham it up a bit these days. I am growing stronger as I face my fears.

Take that first step (even if it is white-knuckled) in sharing who Jesus is to you with someone else. The more you face that fear, the less the fear disables you. The more you trust in the Lord, the less the fear disables you.

Read Hebrews 13:6 and John 14:27.

There was a challenge issued to our CornerStone Group in *The Workbook on Abiding in Christ*, "Seek out at least two persons today to tell them that you are on this workbook journey and that today you are thinking about the Incarnation. See how they respond..." Go ahead, give it a try. Don't let fear stop you from sharing the love of God to a world (to a person) who desperately needs Jesus.

Questions of the day:

Do you have a fear of sharing the Gospel? Why? Ask God to help you overcome that fear.






October Item of the month: CLOTHING
